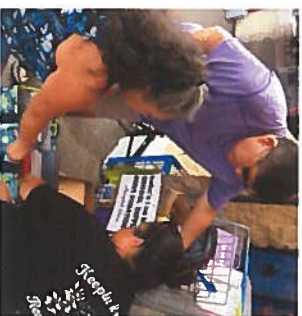
A HISTORY OF UNITING OUR COMMUNITY
